

# The Daily Double

## DESCRIPTION

Consists of two consecutive races designated as the Daily Double. The player selects entries that he thinks will win in each of the two races. It is suggested that the Daily Double be played in the Fourth Race and in the Fifth Race. For the purpose of clarification we shall refer to these two races as the Daily Double races.

## PROCEDURE FOR PLAYING THE DAILY DOUBLE

A two part, perforated, serial numbered ticket in pad form is used. Each part bears the same printed serial number. The player notifies the teller of his choices which are written on both portions of the ticket. The lower portion is presented to the player; the top portion is retained on the pad.

When the sale of tickets is declared closed, the selling of the Daily Double Tickets ceases immediately.

## CALCULATING THE PAYOFFS ON THE COMPUTATION (CONTROL) SHEET

- 1) On the Computation (Control) Sheet on the line after "Number of Daily Double Tickets Sold", enter the number of tickets sold.
- 2) Enter the amount collected on the line after "Total Amount Collected".
- 3) Subtract the "Commission" from the "Total Amount Collected". The resulting figure is the "Winners' Share" (Net Pool).
- 4) After the Fourth Race is run, an entry indicating the winner is made in the column headed "Winner Fourth Race".
- 5) The teller then selects from all the top portions of the Daily Double Tickets those stubs bearing the corresponding winning number in the first box only.
- 6) Referring to the second box on these same tickets, the teller then enters strokes in the column headed "Holders of Daily Double Combination" to indicate the number of players that have selected each specific entry as the possible winner of the Fifth Race.
- 7) Divide the "Winners' Share" (Net Pool) by the total number of players indicated on each line. Enter this figure in the appropriate space in the column headed "Winner To Pay".

## SUGGESTIONS

- 1) In the event that there is no Daily Double winner, the Net Pool may be carried over to the Sixth Race to increase the winners' share. This should be done only after the commission from the Sixth Race has been subtracted in order to avoid deducting the commission twice from the Daily Double money.
- 2) In the event that there is no Daily Double winner, the "Winners' Share" (Net Pool) may be divided equally among those players holding the first part winner of the Daily Double.

## IMPORTANT

If the procedure outlined in either 1 or 2 above is to be followed, the audience MUST be so informed before running the Daily Double races.
